**SUBJECT : IMPORTED LIVE BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY
MEAT, DAY OLD CHICKS, EGGS, SEMEN SOURCED FROM AVIAN
INFLUENZA-FREE, ACCREDITED COUNTRIES ON TRANSSHIPMENT
FROM NAIA TERMINALS 1, 2, 3, 4 FOR SHIPMENT TO VISAYAS AND
MINDANAO**

Please be informed that the Department of Agriculture-Bureau of Animal Industry will allow the transshipment of **IMPORTED LIVE BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY OLD CHICKS, EGGS, SEMEN SOURCED FROM AVIAN INFLUENZA-FREE, ACCREDITED COUNTRIES FROM NAIA TERMINALS 1, 2, 3, 4 FOR SHIPMENT TO VISAYAS AND MINDANAO** subject to the following conditions:

- Upon arrival from the international airline flight, the cargoes must be loaded to the domestic airline flight (not necessarily chartered flight);
- The cargoes must not leave the confines of the NAIA Terminals 1, 2, 3, 4;
- Cargoes from international flight cannot be offloaded and transferred to another vehicle for loading at the North Harbor Port in Manila;
- Ensure that the SPS Import Clearance, International Veterinary Certificate, and other import documentary requirements are in order and that the cargo is accompanied by a shipping permit issued by the NAIA Veterinary Quarantine Officers.

These transshipment procedures shall be enforced until such time that there are no new cases reported 21 days after the depopulation of the affected areas.

This Circular shall take effect immediately.
