

### III. COMMON CAUSE OF REJECTION OF APPLICATIONS:

- a. Information in the required fields is incomplete
- b. Documents expired
- c. Fake, recycled, fake documentation
- d. Application inconsistencies
- e. The supporting document is not directly linked to the application. Ex. Commodity applied is tocino, attachment is burger patty.
- f. The meat certificate inspection date is not consistent with the application date  
Ex. Actual application date is February 4, 2020, date of inspection in attached COMI is February 7, 2020.,
- g. Inadequate requirements
- h. Incomplete information in the documentations
- i. The products' destination is subject to current legal restrictions. Ex. Executive order banning pig and pork products
- j. Commodity origin is subject to existing legal restrictions ex. Movement of pigs from ASF outbreak areas is prohibited
- k. Blurred or unreadable documentary attachments and improper positioning of document orientation

**This Circular shall take effect immediately until revoked in writing.**
